“BUY RECYCLED” POLICY



Purpose

Haars Nursery is committed to supporting the use of recycled materials and contributing to a circular economy. This policy outlines our commitment to purchasing products and materials that contain recycled content wherever feasible.

Policy

- 1. Procurement Practices:** Haars Nursery will prioritise the purchase of products and materials that contain recycled content, where it is feasible and cost-effective.
- 2. Recycled Content Requirements:** Suppliers will be encouraged to provide products and materials with a minimum recycled content as specified by relevant standards or guidelines.
- 3. Product Categories:** Haars Nursery will identify key product categories where the use of recycled content is feasible and set targets for increasing the purchase of recycled products in these categories.

4. Supplier Engagement: Haars Nursery will work with suppliers to promote the use of recycled content and explore opportunities for collaboration on sustainable procurement practices.

5. Employee Awareness: Haars Nursery will raise awareness among employees about the benefits of buying recycled and provide training on sustainable procurement practices.

6. Reporting and Monitoring: Haars Nursery will track and report on the purchase of recycled products and materials, setting targets for increasing the use of recycled content over time.

7. Continuous Improvement: Haars Nursery will review and update this policy regularly to reflect advances in sustainable procurement practices and the availability of new recycled products and materials.

Implementation

This policy will be communicated to all employees, suppliers, and stakeholders, and compliance will be monitored and enforced by Haars Nursery's management team.

Review

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure its effectiveness and relevance to Haars Nursery's sustainability goals.
